Greentube gains Pennsylvania regulatory nod to enter fourth state

Greentube has maintained its ambition for expansion across the US following a further licensing, with the state of Pennsylvania becoming the latest to award the gaming studio with a licence to supply its games in the region.

As a result of the regulatory nod being issued by the **Pennsylvania Gaming Control Board**, the online casino content supplier will look to make headway into a jurisdiction that was the third largest in terms of total gaming revenue through the past month.

Last month, the PGCB **declared** revenue of \$476.7m, up 3.27 per cent year-on-year (April 2022: \$461.6m) but down when compared to March's \$515.3m.

However, online casino games maintained an upward trend after tracking revenue of \$137.21m through the 31 days, up 21.3 per cent YoY from \$113.1m.

The interactive gaming manufacturer licence will enable Greentube to offer a portfolio of titles that includes the Diamond Cash and Thunder Cash series, as well as more recent releases, such as Money Maker.

Pennsylvania is the fourth US state where the company has gained a permit since January 2022, joining Connecticut, New Jersey and Michigan.

Löwen Entertainment beschloss die Preise in der Kantine beizubehalten und die Steuerersparnis für 2020 der Binger Tafel zugutekommen zu lassen. 2021 und 2022 wurde die Regelung jeweils um ein weiteres Jahr verlängert. Die erneute Ersparnis wird nun an weitere wohltätige Vereine vor Ort als Spende weitergegeben.“
